

Homeschool/Hybrid Program

We have a Homeschool HYBRID Program on Mondays and Wednesdays for students in grades Young 5s to 6th grade. Homeschool students who would like to attend Faith Community Christian and join our student body are welcome to attend! Students who choose to join will be able to participate in the following (and more!): Bible classes, social time, art/STEAM classes, recess, lunch time, chapel, Green Engineering (Wednesdays) and all the subjects taught in the classroom during the day. Our program is meant to provide a framework for homeschooling where parents can follow on "homeschool days" and students are able to stay on track for their grade level.



Tuition and Fees

Lower Elementary and Upper Elementary Pricing

The program is \$110/month per student.

Additional Fees:

\$100 registration fee

\$250 curriculum fee

Students who attend our lower and upper elementary program attend two days. it is hosted on Monday and Wednesday. However, if parents would like for children to attend on Tuesday as well, it is an additional cost of \$110/month (pro-rated and not part of the homeschool/hybrid program.

Intermediate Pricing

Students who attend intermediate school will attend 3 days. They will attend Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday.

The cost is \$310/month totaling \$3100.00 for the year.

Intermediate Additional Fees:

\$100 registration fee

\$250 curriculum fee



Additional Notes

All students who attend our Homeschool Hybrid program at Faith Community Christian School are considered full students of Faith. It is our desire to partner with families who desire Christian education for their children.

Faith Community Christian School is a non-denominational school.

TASK HOURS

Parents are asked to volunteer in order to complete TASK hours, which translate as a tuition discount. Parents in our Homeschool Hybrid program must complete 20 hours of TASK hours or later pay \$200.00 at the end of the year (each family may choose which is most convenient for them). TASK hours help FCCS offset the cost of tuition and allow parents to take an active role in the education of children! TASK hours could include caring for grounds while weeding, cutting and laminating for teachers, helping prepare crafts at home, volunteering in the STEAM room, etc. (the list is endless!).
