

## FAITH COMMUNITY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL

Dear Families,

As the school board and staff at FCCS, it is our goal to offer exceptional Christian education while providing outstanding curriculum and instruction. Programs like our green engineering, animal husbandry, robotics team, GROW program with onsite speech and occupational therapy, and dyslexia therapy clearly provide additional educational support and experiences unique to our school. Next year, we are excited to offer new curriculum and opportunities to our 5th and 6th grade students. As we continue to pray for the direction of our growing school, we are faced with financial challenges.

Many have noticed the tuition increase for the 2022/2023 school year. The standard for other local Christian schools is a 4% annual tuition increase. While we strive to keep our tuition cost down, the discrepancy between the money coming in and the cost to operate the school is too great to overcome. While we realize that the tuition increase for next year is significant for all of us, you may be surprised to learn that tuition only covers 72% of the school's total expenses. School operating costs include paying our amazing staff, a large portion of curriculum costs, utilities, cleaning, office supplies, insurance, technology, and maintenance. You should also know that our staff makes about 20% less than the average public school teacher. Our staff chooses to be here because they believe in Christian education and love our kids! Christian education is a choice. When chosen, it becomes our responsibility as a school community to cover the remaining 28% of the cost to operate the school. This typically comes in the form of fundraising and donations.

If we do not include fundraising and donations to supplement operating costs at Faith and rely solely on tuition to run the school, the cost of education at Faith would be as follows:

Preschool: \$6,656 Young 5's: \$5,990.40 Kindergarten: \$6220.80 Grades 1-4: \$6,246.80 Grades 5-6: \$6,656

We, as a community, do not want this.

Additionally, we provide the lowest tuition rate in comparison to other local Christian schools, such as: Rockford Christian (\$9,300 - \$9,800), Ada Christian (\$10,975), Algoma Christian (\$6,505), and Grant Christian (\$5,860). We make every dollar count *and* stretch.

In order to meet our financial obligations without a major tuition increase, we need to come together as a community. This has ALWAYS been the Faith way. As we continue to look for an additional revenue stream to supplement operating costs, our immediate needs include help with fundraising, volunteer services, and donations. Please consider how you and your family (this includes grandparents, aunts and uncles, neighbors) can help contribute; keeping in mind that all volunteer activities count toward your 40 annual TASK hours.
